25% Energy Savings Replaces 30 Year Old Boilers At Church Park Residences



Church Park Residences is a bustling community of apartments and commercial space located in downtown Boston. For over 30 years the complex was supported by three Kewanee boilers that provided heat and hot water for over 500 apartments and several businesses. Constant maintenance and repairs were needed to keep everything running while the energy bills continued to rise.

Wilkinson recently completed an ambitious project that resulted in a total transformation of the boiler room facilities. The old fire tube boilers were replaced with seven AERCO Benchmark 3000's condensing boilers which enabled Church Park to gain valuable space. New AERCO Smart Plate domestic hot water heat exchangers were installed that deliver precise temperature control without the need for storage tanks and blending valves.

As a result of all the upgrades that were completed, Church Park now enjoys one of the most efficient boiler facilities in the city of Boston. According to John Davenport of Church Park,

the numbers that are being reported are quite impressive, "In the first and second quarters of this year we're realizing savings between 20-25%. The project was completed without a hitch and the results continue to be fantastic".

Wilkinson Achieves High Marks For Efficiency and Savings at Wheaton College





Wilkinson recently received a call From Wheaton College on a Friday morning around 10:30am regarding a dormitory boiler failure. Wheaton requested an immediate installation of a new boiler but all parties agreed that a mobile boiler would be the logical solution at the time. The mobile boiler was delivered and fully hooked up to the systems by 5:30pm that same day, preventing the students to have any loss of heat.

Wheaton was already considering replacing the existing boiler to become more efficient. After consulting further with Wilkinson, a longer term solution emerged that became more feasible. Gary Pavao is the Chief Engineer of the physical and power plants at the college. "Wilkinson has a great deal of experience in this area and came up with a terrific solution. They were able to respond to our needs in a very timely and professional fashion.

Wilkinson installed two Weil McLain ULTRA 399 hydronic boilers with two indirect domestic hot water generators. The system will operate at efficiency above 90% and the combustion was vented in PVC. This allowed for the removal of the antiquated chimney and removal from service.


